WOODSIDE FELLOWSHIP:

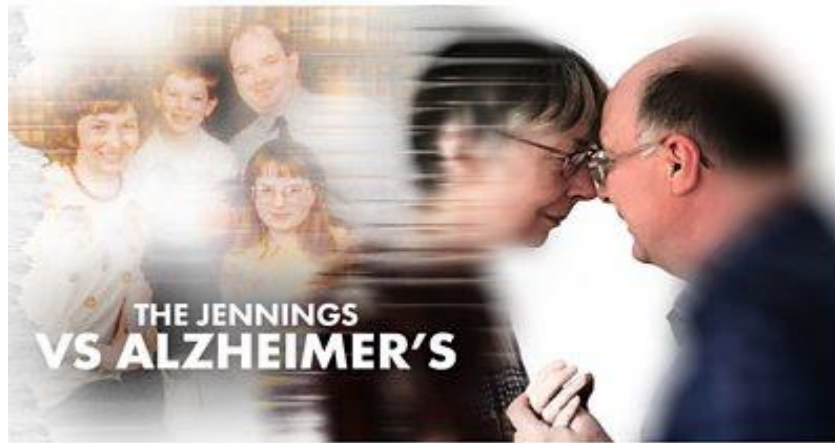
